**STIPULATION AND ORDER AUTHORIZING
AUTOMATIC PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS**

(No Hearing Required)

TO THE DEBTOR'S EMPLOYER:

The above named Debtor and the Debtor's Chapter 13 bankruptcy Trustee have agreed as follows:

1. The Debtor has proposed a Chapter 13 bankruptcy plan that requires the Debtor to make monthly payments to the Chapter 13 Trustee, William A. Van Meter. The Debtor has voluntarily agreed that it is in his or her best interest to utilize direct payroll deductions to implement the Chapter 13 Plan.
2. The Debtor has agreed that the Employer should deduct \$ _____ each month from the Debtor's paychecks for this purpose and that this amount should be sent on a regular basis to the Trustee so long as the Debtor remains in the Chapter 13 case.
3. The Debtor wishes that these voluntary payroll deductions commence prior to confirmation of the Debtor's Chapter 13 Plan.

4. The deductions from the Debtor's pay shall be transmitted by delivery of a check with a notation indicating the Debtor's name and bankruptcy case number and made payable to WILLIAM A. VAN METER, TRUSTEE. The check shall be delivered to the following address:

5. This Order should supersede any previous Order made to you related to wage assignments in the Debtor's bankruptcy case. This Order shall have no effect in any other Chapter 13 cases in which the Employer may be making payroll deductions in other Chapter 13 cases.
