Fee

In addition, many bankruptcy courts accept credit cards for payment of court fees by attorneys and law firms.

Caption

1. Identify the Judicial District in which the bankruptcy case was filed. Example: "Eastern District of California."
2. "In re": Insert the name of the debtor as it appears in the bankruptcy petition.
3. "Case No.": Insert the bankruptcy case number assigned at the time of filing.

This form is for use when someone needs proof of the filing of a petition. The clerk should issue this form only upon specific application.

This form, which previously was designated as Official Form No. 5, was abrogated as an Official Form and reissued as a Director's procedural form.
