

NOTE: The following form complies with the provisions of the Trademark Law Treaty Implementation Act (TLTIA).

WHEN TO FILE: You must file a Statement of Use within six (6) months after the mailing of the Notice of Allowance, UNLESS, within that same period, you submit a request for a six-month extension of time to file the Statement of Use. The request for an extension must:

- be filed in the USPTO within six (6) months after the issue date of the Notice of Allowance, or previously- granted extension period;
- include a verified statement of the owner's continued bona fide intention to use the mark in commerce;
- specify the goods/services to which the request pertains as they are identified in the Notice of Allowance; and
- include a fee of \$100 for each class of goods/services.

You may request five (5) extensions of time. No extensions may extend beyond thirty-six (36) months from the issue date of the Notice of Allowance. The USPTO must receive the second (2nd), third (3rd), fourth (4th), and fifth (5th) extensions within the previously-granted extension period. Do NOT wait until the request for extension has been granted before filing the next request. In addition to the requirements described above, the second (2nd) and subsequent requests must specify applicant's ongoing efforts to use the mark in commerce.

You may submit one (1) extension request during the six-month period in which you file the Statement of Use, unless the granting of this request would extend the period beyond thirty-six (36) months from the issue date of the Notice of Allowance. Instead of specifying ongoing efforts, for this request you should state the belief that the owner has made valid use of the mark in commerce, as evidenced by the Statement of Use, but that if the USPTO finds the Statement defective, the owner will require additional time to file a new Statement of Use.

If the original application were based on both Section 1(a) (Use in Commerce) and 1(b) (Intent to Use), this extension request is necessary only for those goods that were based on Section 1(b). You should NOT file an Extension Request (or Statement of Use) for those goods that were filed based on use in commerce.

BASIC INSTRUCTIONS

The following form is written in a "scannable" format that will enable the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) to scan paper filings and capture application data automatically using optical character recognition (OCR) technology. Information is to be entered next to identifying data tags, such as <MARK>. OCR software can be programmed to identify these tags, capture the corresponding data, and transmit this data to the appropriate data fields in the Trademark databases, largely bypassing manual data entry processes.

Please enter the requested information in the blank space that appears to the right of each tagged (< >) element. However, do not enter any information immediately after the section headers (the bolded wording appearing in all capital letters). Some of the information requested *must* be provided. Other information is either required only in certain circumstances, or provided only at your discretion. **Please consult the "Help" section following the form for detailed explanations as to what information should be entered in each blank space.**

To increase effectiveness of the USPTO scanners, it is recommended that you use a typewriter to complete the form.

LINE-BY-LINE HELP INSTRUCTIONS

TRADEMARK/SERVICE MARK INFORMATION

Mark: Enter the word mark in typed form; or, in the case of a design or stylized mark, a brief description of the mark (e.g., “Design of a fanciful cat”).

Serial Number: Enter the eight-digit USPTO serial number (e.g., 75/453687).

APPLICANT INFORMATION

Name: Enter the full name of the owner of the mark, i.e., the name of the individual, corporation, partnership, or other entity that is seeking registration. If a joint venture organized under a particular business name, enter that name. If joint or multiple applicants, enter the name of each of these applicants. If a trust, enter the name of the trustee or trustees. If an estate, enter the name of the executor or executors.

Note: If ownership of the application has changed, you should establish current ownership, either by (1) recording the appropriate document(s) with the USPTO Assignment Branch; or (2) submitting evidence with this declaration, such as a copy of a document transferring ownership from one party to another. To have the USPTO databases reflect the current owner, you must choose option (1).

Street: Enter the street address or rural delivery route where the owner is located.

The filing fee for the Request for Extension of Time to file a Statement of Use is \$100.00 *per class*.

Number of Classes: Enter the number of classes (*not* the international class number(s)) to which the Extension Request applies. For example, if the Extension Request applies to Classes 1, 5 and 25, then the number of classes entered would be “3.”

Total Filing Fee Paid: Enter fee amount enclosed (either in form of check or money order in U.S. currency, made payable to “Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks”), or to be charged to an already-existing USPTO deposit account.

Signature: The appropriate person must sign the form. Name: Enter the name of the person signing the form.

CERTIFICATE OF MAILING

Although optional, use will avoid lateness due to mail delay. The USPTO considers papers timely filed if deposited with the U.S. States Postal Service with sufficient postage as first class mail on or before the due date, *and* accompanied by a signed Certificate of Mailing attesting to timely deposit. The USPTO will look to the date shown on the Certificate of Mailing, rather than date of actual receipt, to determine timeliness.

Date of Deposit: Enter the date of deposit with the United States Postal Service as first class mail.

Signature: The person signing the certificate should have a reasonable basis to expect that the correspondence will be mailed on or before the indicated date.

Name: Enter the name of the person signing the Certificate of Mailing.
