PLAN and/or APPLICATION FOR ATTORNEY'S FEES
Notice of Potential for Dismissal or Conversion

Enclosed is a copy of the chapter 13 plan proposed by the debtor(s). If you object to confirmation of the plan, or payment of the attorney fees contained therein, you must file the original and one (1) copy of your written objection with the Clerk of the Court, United States Bankruptcy Court, 2120 Capitol Avenue, Ste. 6004, Cheyenne, WY 82004, within 28 days after the date of the mailing of this notice and you must serve a copy of your objection on the debtor(s), whose address is _____, the attorney for the debtor(s), whose name and address appear below, and the standing chapter 13 trustee, _____, whose address is _____.

In the absence of a written objection to the value of the collateral and secured status asserted in the plan, the court may accept the allegations of value of a secured creditor's collateral in the plan, determine the value pursuant to § 506(a), and confirm the plan without further notice or hearing.

If objections are timely filed, the court will set and hold a hearing. If the plan is not confirmed, the court may consider dismissal or conversion of the case at that time.

If no objections are timely filed, the court may enter an order confirming the plan without further notice or hearing.
